Genesis MCM Primary Areas of Focus (The 3 I's):

1) Intimacy with God

- a. John 17:3 – “And this is the way to have eternal life—to know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, the one you sent to earth.”
- b. Spending time with God (seeking to know Him and His will) is the foundation of being a disciple of Jesus

2) Investing in the life of others

- a. John 13:34 – “So now I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other.”
- b. We are intentional about spending time with others and loving them the way God showed His love for us through Jesus.

3) Inviting Others

- a. Romans 10:14-15 – “But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them? And how will anyone go and tell them without being sent? That is why the Scriptures say, “How beautiful are the feet of messengers who bring good news!””
- b. To share their story, hear your story, and hear God’s story
- c. To take the next step on their faith journey
- d. To join/start a gathering

What is a micro-church gathering like?

We use a 3-part process when we meet:

1) Looking Back

- a. Care & worship – we do some or all the following to start our time together
 - i. Share a meal together.
 - ii. How has everyone’s personal relationship with God been? If anyone is struggling, pray for him/her, and stay after to care for that person.
 - iii. Spend some time worshiping God through singing and prayer, using any spiritual gifts God has given your Group.
- b. Checking-in
 - i. How have you obeyed what you have learned?
 - ii. Who have you trained in what you have learned?
 - iii. With whom have you shared your story or God’s story
- c. Vision
 - i. Reminder of why we gather and do what we do

2) Looking Up

- a. Pray

- b. Read and discuss Scripture
 - i. What did you like about this passage?
 - ii. What did you find challenging about this passage?
 - c. Read again
 - i. What does this passage teach about God?
 - ii. What does this passage teach about people?
- 3) Looking Ahead
- a. Pray, listen, & make commitments
 - i. How will you obey this passage?
 - ii. Who will you train with this passage?
 - iii. With whom will you share your story or God's story?
 - b. Practice
 - i. Sharing your story or God's story
 - ii. Role-play a conversation you may have
 - c. Close in prayer
